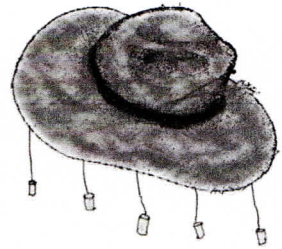


Waltzing Matilda

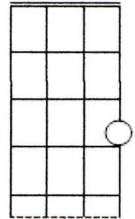
For Ukulele Key: C

"You'll come a-waltzing ma-tilda with me".

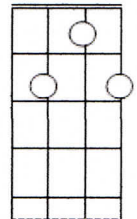

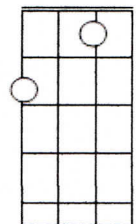
Chorus: C F
